The late C D Brooks often said that one could go down into the watery grave of baptism a dry devil, and come up a wet one. By implication, one can be in the church, and not be in Christ, because no inward change has taken place in us, even though we were baptized into the church. Paul used that phrase "*in Christ Jesus*" 47 times in his letters. What does it mean to be *in Christ Jesus*?

In Romans 8:1,2 he says there is therefore now no condemnation to them which are *in Christ Jesus*...for the law of the Spirit of life *in Christ Jesus* has set us free from the law of sin and death. The first effect for those who are found in Christ is that a legal verdict of no condemnation is applied to your account in the records of heaven. The second effect for those who are *in Christ Jesus* is that the power of the Spirit of life *in Christ Jesus* has made us free from the law of sin and death. The power of the Spirit has conquered the power of sin in your life and has set you free. The power of God's Spirit brings a transformative experience and a legal verdict of no condemnation into our lives. How then do I get in Christ? 1 Cor. 1:30 says: from God you are *in Christ Jesus*. In other words, by faith in God, you may experience transformation. It is a work that God desires to do in us, and if we will consent, He will do it for us by having faith in Him.

It is the prayer of this administration that we will allow Christ to work in and through us so that in the records of heaven don't just see us in church, but also *in Christ*. In Christ and Christ alone is this experience made possible.

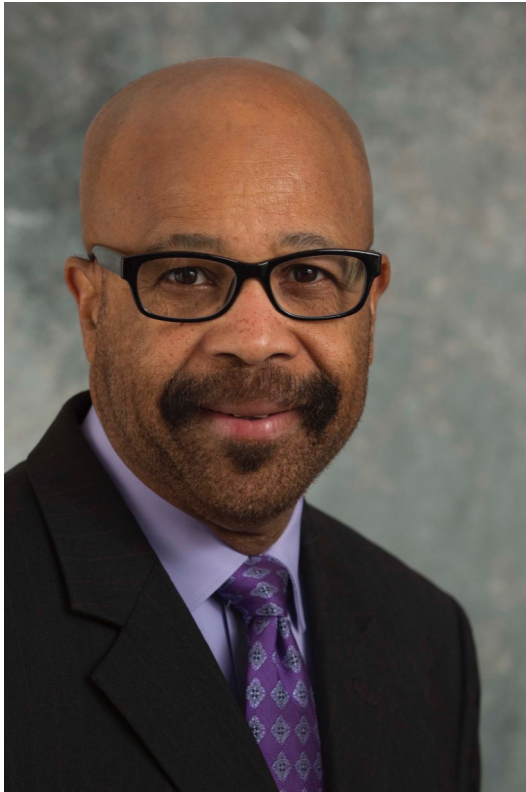

DR. CLIFFORD JONES

Dr. R. Clifford Jones currently serves as President of the Lake Region Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, which was organized in 1944 and is currently headquartered in Mokena, Illinois. Spanning the states of Minnesota, Wisconsin, Illinois, Michigan, and Indiana, the Lake Region Conference boasts a membership of approximately 30,000, and, under the leadership of Dr. Jones, is pursuing a strategic path that inspires members to encounter Christ, engender change, and enrich communities.

When he was elected in 2014 as the President of the first Regional Conference to be organized, Dr. Jones was serving as the Associate Dean of the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary at Andrews University in Berrien Springs, Michigan. Prior to that role, he served as the Chair of the Christian Ministry Department, and as an Associate Professor and Professor in that department. Because of his deep love for pastoral ministry, while teaching full time he also served as the senior pastor of the New Life Fellowship at Andrews University from 1997-2004, and as the senior pastor of the All Nations SDA Church in Berrien Springs, Michigan, from 2006-2014.

Before joining the Andrews University faculty in 1995, Dr. Jones pastored in the Northeastern Conference of Seventh-day Adventists from 1979-1995, distinguishing himself in that field as a pastor/evangelist. He was ordained in 1983 and concluded his ministry in the Northeastern Conference by pastoring the two largest African American congregations in New York City—the Hanson Place SDA Church in Brooklyn, New York (1987-1991); and the Ephesus SDA Church in Harlem, New York (1992-1995). From 1991-1995, Dr. Jones also served as an adjunct professor in the Doctor of Ministry program at New York Theological Seminary.

Although Dr. Jones received his ministerial training at Atlantic Union College, he earned his undergraduate degree from Fitchburg State University. He graduated with an MA (Religion) from Andrews University in 1979, and with a Doctor of Ministry from New York Theological Seminary in 1989. In 2001, he earned the Doctor of Philosophy from Western Michigan University.

A sought-after presenter in the areas of African American studies, leadership development, and mission and ministry, Dr. Jones is the author of numerous professional and scholarly articles, and has contributed chapters to several books. He has edited two books on preaching (*Preaching with Power* and *Preaching with Power II*), and is the author of *James K Humphrey and the Sabbath-Day Adventists*, an African American History text that examines the break from the Adventist church of the premiere black pastor in Adventism in the early 20th century.

Dr. Jones is married to the former Elva A. Williams, a graduate of Atlantic Union College (BA, Elementary Education) and Andrews University (MA, Education), and they are the proud parents of two adult children—Clifford, Jr. and Jewel.



PASTOR STEVE RILEY

Steve W. A. Riley currently serves as the Communication Director of the South Caribbean Conference and senior pastor of the Mt. D'Or SDA. Pastor Riley has been in ministry for over twenty-nine (29) years and as an ardent member of this auspicious fraternity has functioned in various capacities including producer, host and presenter for no less than twenty six (26) years on various church sponsored media programs (television and radio).

He previously served as Associate Communication Director, 2007-2015, and was the co-producer and speaker of the first ever NET evangelistic series conducted in the Caribbean entitled, '*BREAKING NEWS.*'

Pastor Riley's ability to unearth and proclaim Biblical truth in such a profound way has led him to stand behind various religious pulpits around the world including the Caribbean: *Grenada, Barbados, Suriname, Antigua, St. Vincent, St. Lucia, Guyana, Jamaica and the Cayman Islands; US Virgin Islands: St. Croix and St. Thomas; and the British Virgin Islands of Anguilla.*

Other nations include: *Bermuda, The Bahamas, Venezuela, England, Canada, the United States, Nigeria, & South Africa.* Perhaps one of his most notable speaking assignments to date was when he ascended the platform of the General Conference Session 2010 as one of the devotional presenters.

Pastor Steve and Stacy Riley have been married for over (20) years. Such a union has produced two (2) girls, teenager Shaelerece (*'shay-ler-reece'*), and the younger girl Shinead (*'shir-nade'*). With these two precious gifts from God they both insist that their quiver is full!
